Pain Management Programme

King Edward VII's Hospital is inviting participants for their next Veterans' Pain Management Programme (PMP). The PMP is designed to help veterans with on-going pain to improve the quality of their lives; it is not based on trying to provide a cure, the overall aims being;

- To improve physical functioning and ability
- To improve the person's understanding and beliefs about their pain condition
- To reduce pain related distress
- To review and reduce medication with debilitating side effects
- To develop ways to manage pain flare-ups

If selected, there will be an interdisciplinary assessment followed by a 5-day residential programme in London, plus a further 5 days of compulsory single programme appointments.

King Edward VII's Hospital will provide the medical treatment for free as well as the travel costs, accommodation and meals. Residential accommodation is based on twin-room sharing.

This Programme is suitable for:

Veterans suffering from persistent pain, motivated to actively engage in a group-based Pain Management Programme.
